

Planning Commission Minutes of March 6, 2013

We looked at all of the options for a new airport terminal and really saw no real opposition to any of the plans. The Number 4 seemed the easiest to do. There will be an 8,000 square foot increase in the size of the new facility and it will have all of the modern conveniences. We discussed the parking concepts and recommended a pedestrian crossing in order to make the airport more friendly to traffic from town. Rettew is the consultant on the projet and Grant Smith led the presentation for them. Tom Hart was there; as was Mark Murawski the board chairman. This was a plenary meeting with more to follow.

The same idea held true for the Euro-Optics presentation. This was an initial meeting and we did recommend to council that (at the site of the house adjoining the borough property) the zoning map hold primacy. We looked at traffic patterns and general construction of the building. Brooks Engineering is consultant for Alex Ray on this project.
