

The Planning Commission heard two different proposals this evening. One involved a request by Mr. and Mrs. Wayne Rockey to build a small house to rent on their property at the corner of Winters Lane and Jordan Avenue. The edifice will be on Jordan. This case has already been heard and a variance granted by the Zoning Hearing Board due to the shortage of square feet involved in the lot. We saw no reason not to recommend this for passage.

Bill and Rosemary Holmes wish to build a new shop to replace the one recently destroyed by fire. It would actually be a reduction in total square feet. Discussion seemed to lean in the direction of the building being placed perpendicular to Peters Alley rather than parallel in order to gain a swift route around the building. There being no dissent, the owner was asked to report to Matt Sauers for additional instructions.
