

The Planning Commission convened in council chambers at 7:00 with Tony Salvatori, Lynn Smith, Chris Reed, and Don King in attendance. Eugene Boyles represented council and also present were Mr. and Mrs. Worthington representing their business interest, Steve Perks representing Flint and Herm Logue representing his interests. John Staron attended as a citizen observer.

Herm Logue had already been approved for a Land Development on his property on West Broad Street. He was present to request an addition to the truck wash in order to make the project cost effective.
